Nathan McFall, born in Suitland, Maryland, has been using his anointed voice and God given talent to sing and play the piano, electrifying audiences since the age of one. Singing with his teacher, his Aunt Shirley, in church and with the Shirley Ables Music Ministry was the beginning of his career. He is presently the Minister of Music at Emanuel Baptist Church in Washington DC under the leadership of Pastor Christopher L. Nichols. He's been a faithful member of Macedonia Baptist Church in SE, Washington, DC for ten years, where Rev. Garfield Burton is pastor.
